In the first three quarters of 2019, ŠKODA AUTO delivered 913,700 vehicles to customers worldwide. Thanks to the strong growth in Eastern Europe (+10.6%) and Western Europe (+6.8%) as well as in Russia (+7.0%), **the carmaker was able to increase deliveries in these regions significantly** and compensate for the current market development in China.

NEW COMPANY IN INDIA

MODERN PAINT SHOP AT MLADÁ BOLESLAV

ŠKODA AUTO has opened a new paint shop at its main plant in Mladá Boleslav. Up to 168,000 car bodies will be painted there each year, taking the plant's total annual painting capacity up to 812,000 vehicles. The facility is one of **the most cutting-edge and eco-friendly of its kind in Europe.** Robots assist in numerous production steps.



ELECTRIC COMPONENTS FOR VW GROUP VEHICLES

ŠKODA AUTO has started production of high-voltage traction batteries for plug-in hybrids. The batteries are used in **plug-in hybrids on the MQB platform, for example ŠKODA SUPERB iV.** Over the next few years, ŠKODA AUTO will increase its initial production capacity of 150,000 units per year.
